

TRAVEL LEAGUE RULES

These are exceptions to the current Rule Book To **Establish OHSBL Travel League for classifications F and G.**

1. Team shall be made up of players from their respective charters.
 - This is a charter option if you want to participate.
 - Charters have the complete control of putting together a team and its coaching together.
 - Any team that is put together as a traveling team can not be put back into the league as a league team the following year.
 - For this Travel League to work The Charter must be involved and stay involved.
2. Rosters
 - Special Travel League rosters will be provided by the OHSBL.
 - Each Team shall have a minimum of 12 players.
3. Two inning rule will not be used in this league.
4. Pitch count restrictions will be used for the travel league.
 - G League pitch count will be a maximum of 60 pitches.
 - F League pitch count will be maximum of 75 pitches
 - At the 60th or 75th pitch the pitcher must be removed as a pitcher.
 - Penalty for violation of this rule is the pitcher can not pitch in the next travel league game.
5. Uniforms.
 - Minimum requirements for a uniform is
 - Like cap
 - Tee shirt with a number
 - League pants can be used
6. Game scheduling will be done in unison with all charters that are participating in the Travel League.
 - Tournament Games will start the last week end in June and can not be played after the third Wed prior to the start of OHSBL Districts but can be continued after the OHSBL tournament finals.
7. Tournament Play
 - Any Tournament play that is set up must be approved by the Executive Committee.
 - Tournament cost will be 100 dollars with 50% going to OHSBL and 50% going to the tournament sites
 - Tournament will be a Flite tournament of at least three games
 - The best record in the flite brackets shall advance to the championship round.
 - The team's brackets are to be picked by pill per T15.04 D3
 - If teams are tied by record at the end of bracket play the first tie breaker is runs allowed, then by runs scored, and finally by coin flip.
8. Web site has been developed to track team's progress and track pitcher's pitch count and innings pitched.

The Executive Committee in unison with the participating charters reserves the right to amend or delete all parts of the Travel League Rules and Regulations to strengthen or expand its scope.
